Although we are large, our providers are local to each community they serve:

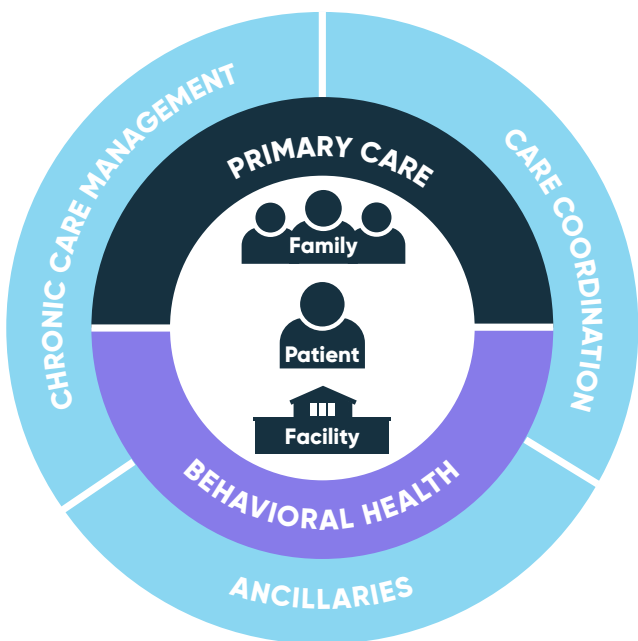

The Eventus Clinical Model of Integrated Care

At Eventus our care teams collaborate to develop a complete primary care and behavioral healthcare plan that is tailored to you or your loved one. All patients receive primary care with optional behavioral health services based on medical necessity.

Our Care Teams include:

- Physicians
- Psychiatrists
- Psychologists and Psychotherapist
- Advanced Care Providers (NPs & PAs)
- Medical Assistants, Care Coordinators, and Administrative Support Staff



All Eventus team members are specialists in the needs of people living in long-term care.

The Eventus Way – Integrated Clinical Model of Care

Primary Care

- Clinical Care team includes an Advanced Practice Provider (NP or PA) a physician and a medical assistant
- Members of the care team are in-person in the community to provide care on regularly scheduled days and all consented patients are seen every 30-days or more frequently if experiencing an acute health issue
- 24/7 coverage is provided by the clinical care team as well as the Eventus Triage team

Behavioral Health

Psychiatric Med Management

- Clinical team is made up of a psychiatric specialty trained NP or PA and supported by a Psychiatrist.
- The clinical team is in the community on a regular basis and all consented patients are seen every 30-days
- Services include full evaluation of mental health concerns and cognitive assessments

Psychotherapy

- Non-pharmacological care provided by professional therapists and psychologists
- Visit frequency determined by individual patient medical necessity

Care Coordination and Chronic Care Management

- Team of dedicated care coordinators provides support to all clinicians in the field
- Providers collaborate with one another, facility staff, and patients' families to ensure a seamless care journey for patients
- Chronic Care Management team and care coordinators ensure care plans are properly integrated and services are delivered and documented
- Communicate with patients and families directly and through the Patient Portal
- Provide assistance in the coordination of specialty services not provided by Eventus at the facility
